Campus Security, Director: Provides the overall strategic direction of Campus Security and Access Services

Associate Director: Oversees the Campus Security team

Access Services Manager: Oversees the Access Services team

Operations Manager: Day-to-day operations of Patrol Operation

Assistant Manager, Operations Support: Administration, Support Services and Community Relations

Community Safety Zone Manager: Works with UBC Administrators and client focused

Operations Supervisor: Provides scheduling and task scheduling, and responds to security requests

Community Relations Officer: Crime Prevention and Trend Analysis

Shift Supervisor: Team supervision and support, and ensuring daily tasks are complete

Communications Operator: Monitor alarms, calls for service, dispatch and communications

Museum Supervisor: Supervises the Museum of Anthropology (MOA) security team

Patrol Officers: Proactive patrols, engage with students, faculty and staff, provides professional security services
